What documents do I need to apply?

 - The required documents outlined below: (all NON-BPS applicants must reside in the City of Buffalo and upload the required documents at the bottom of the application in order to apply for the admissions test):
 - Student's Birth Certificate;
 - Photo Identification for parent/guardian;
 - **(2) Distinct proofs of City of Buffalo residency** (Choose 2 different proofs from the list of the 4 below showing your Buffalo address): **(1)** Parent/guardian New York State driver's license or non-driver's license; **(2)** gas, electric, or cable bill within the last 30 days (only one utility bill can be used); **(3)** parent/guardian's pay stub within the last 30 days; or **(4)** Notice of Decision from the Erie County Department of Social Services from 2021 or 2022;
 - Student's **report card for marking periods 1 and 2** from 2020-2021;
 - Student's **attendance record for marking periods 1 and 2** from 2020-2021 (may appear on report card);
 - Current IEP, 504, or English Language Learner documents, if applicable.
