

Dress Code

The SBCS dress code is designed to encourage a clean, neat, and modest appearance that is in keeping with a serious intellectual atmosphere. It is the responsibility of each student to be familiar with the dress code and adhere to it on a daily basis. Dress code will be checked at the beginning of each day for grades K-6 and at the beginning of each period for grades 7-8 while attendance is being taken. If a student is discovered out of compliance with the dress code they will be required to remedy the situation immediately. If the apparel is not in school they will be expected to call home to obtain the necessary dress code items. If there is no way to remedy the situation the student will be issued a dress code infraction slip.

Gentlemen wear:

- Navy blue SBCS logo shirt (must be tucked in at all times)
- Navy blue SBCS logo sweatshirt
- White short sleeve undershirt may **only** be worn under school polo or sweatshirt
- Khaki dress pants (no cargo or cell phone pocket); (properly sized; must be firmly around waistline)
- Khaki dress shorts (Seasonal only: April 1-October 31)
- Plain navy blue cardigan sweater (button down)
- Plain white socks **only**
- Plain black or brown dress shoes
- Sneakers will be required for gym days **only**. Students will bring in their sneakers and change into them before gym. Students will then be expected to change back into their shoes after gym.
- Kindergarten students are required to have sneakers with **no ties** for gym. (velcro, slip ons or zipper)

Ladies wear:

- Navy blue SBCS logo shirt (must be tucked in at all times)
- Navy blue SBCS logo sweatshirt
- White short sleeve undershirt may **only** be worn under school polo or sweatshirt
- Khaki dress pants (no cargo or cell phone pocket); (properly sized; must be firmly around waistline)
- Khaki dress shorts (Seasonal only: April 1- October 31)
- Khaki skort
- Khaki dress
- Plain navy blue cardigan sweater (button down)
- Plain white socks/plain white tights **only**
- Plain black or brown dress shoes
- Sneakers will be required for gym days only. Students will bring in their sneakers and change into them before gym. Students will then be expected to change back into their shoes after gym.
- Kindergarten students are required to have sneakers with **no ties** for gym. (velcro, slip ons or zipper)

Jewelry wear (applies to all students):

The school will not be held financially responsible for any lost or stolen articles.

- One pair of studs **only** (may be worn as well as in gym. No other jewelry is allowed)

Hair:

- Hair should be kept neat and clean at all times. Hair color other than natural is **not permitted**. Unnaturally died hair is **not permitted**. Parents will be notified that the student must immediately discontinue dying his/her hair and attempt to remedy the color. Exotic or extreme hairstyles, (such as Mohawks or spikes) are **not permitted**. Hair should not hang in any manner which may obstruct the student's eyes. Hair length on boys should not be longer than the top of the shirt collar and not over the top of the ears. Parents will be notified and expected to immediately remedy any hairstyle not in compliance with the SBCS dress code.

General Information:

- Belts must be a solid black or brown **only**
- Sweatpants and gym shorts are **not** allowed
- Make-up: light natural coloring **only** (shades of pink, red and nude will be acceptable)
- Nails: acrylic and fake nails will **not** be allowed
- Nail Polish: light natural coloring **only** (shades of pink, red and nude will be acceptable)
- **No** visible tattoos of any kind
- Purses and/or bags: are **not** allowed to be carried throughout the day
- Hooded sweatshirts are **not permitted** at any time. 8th grade privilege SBCS hooded sweatshirts may be worn by the 8th grade class only.
- **"If an 8th grade student is wearing such a sweatshirt, they must wear the SBCS logo polo underneath."**
- Flip-flops, sandals, clogs, and chunky/platform style shoes are **not permitted**. Winter boots may be worn to school during inclement weather, but students must change into appropriate school shoes immediately upon entering the school building. School shoes may be kept in school to be changed into upon arriving to school.
- Clothing should be neat, clean, in good repair and neither too tight or revealing. Any clothing that displays undergarments is **not permitted**.
- Hats and head covering may not be worn indoors.
