## **SBCS Student Computer Acceptable Use Agreement**

As students are responsible for their behavior in school each day in the halls, classrooms, and on school grounds technology use is no exception to the rules. South Buffalo Charter School provides computers networked and available with internet access for all students attending SBCS. Students are provided with a log-in name and password at the start of each academic year. They are expected to abide by all of the rules and regulations regarding technology utilization. Those students who break the rules and regulations will be subject to disciplinary action and consequences that may result in loss of all privileges and technology resources, suspension from school, and where appropriate law enforcement authorities may be contacted. All students must understand that the following are not permitted on school technology resources:

- Sending, receiving or displaying offensive messages, pictures or other inappropriate or offensive language
- Harassing students, staff, or the public through email pictures, instant messages or other forms of communication.
- Viewing, changing and opening files in someone other than your own home directory.
- Using someone other than your own password and login account
- Employing the network for commercial purposes.
- Violating copyright laws.
